began in 2024 to combat one of the darkest and most heinous atrocities on earth: child trafficking. After hearing a speaker from a Christian non-profit called Destiny Rescue, a group of local Christians felt God calling them to act on behalf of these defenseless and vulnerable children, precious and priceless to God, yet suffering at the hand of oppressors. Rescue Weekend aims to raise both awareness and funds to fight the unthinkable evil of child trafficking. We accomplish this through an annual weekend of events and church services, all featuring a speaker from Destiny Rescue who shares about their work in helping children around the world and about the ultimate rescue mission of Jesus Christ. All funds raised by Rescue Weekend go to Destiny Rescue.



Destiny Rescue is a registered 501(c)(3) Christian non-profit organization that saves kids from human trafficking and helps them stay free. Founded in 2001, they have rescued over 25,000 individuals and their work has helped lead to the arrests of numerous perpetrators. They have over 250 volunteers and staff serving around the clock. Destiny Rescue children through prevention, rescue, and aftercare.
