Project Definition and Expectations

Butler Springs Christian Camp 2024 CULVERT REPLACEMENT PROJECT

The Butler Springs Christian Camp (Camp) is at 3701 State Route 41, in Highland County, Ohio, south-east of Hillsboro. The Camp is in the Appalachian area of South-Central Ohio and lies in a hollow that has a decent stream (Sunfish Creek) that flows through the camp. The stream runs year-round, but with any reasonable rain, it can carry a substantial amount of water. The Camp has a main entry driveway with a secondary driveway on the opposite side of the stream, that services the interior of the camp. There are three existing crossings of the stream, each utilizing varying types of pipes to carry the stream's water (pipe diameters from 18" to 24" each and two to three tubes per crossing). Debris from the valley is a major enemy that plugs up the pipes quite often. The middle crossing has galvanized pipes that have the bottoms completely rusted away, which puts that crossing in jeopardy of collapsing.

The Camp Board plans to replace all three crossings with this project and has been advised that 3' x 10' box culverts would make a considerable improvement. Not dealing with the 100-year flood but reducing the occurrence of overflow to every few years vs the four to seven times annually today and greatly reducing the likelihood of plugging up a crossing.

Attached is a three-sided box culvert design with drawings & specifications for the project, that were supplied by PreTek Group from Bellbrook, Ohio. The stream flows on top of bedrock and the bedrock will provide the base for the footers and structures. Footer pockets are expected to be cut out of the bedrock and then poured in place as per the specifications. The specifications for the three-sided box culverts are such that they can be precast or cast-in-place. Whichever method of fabrication is chosen by the contractor (factors for consideration – property location, ease of installation, timing, expense, etc.).

Each crossing has similar characteristics in that the culverts, wing, and head walls will be the same. Footer heights may vary depending on the bank heights to keep from exceeding the applied material thickness specs on top of structure. Crossing #1 has plans to re-align the bridge to accommodate cleaner stream flow. Each bridge will have safety handrails on both the up & down stream sides of the bridge, as well as the wing walls.

The construction period is specific due to Camp operations and trying to work with typical weather. Summer Camps begin in late May and conclude at the end of July. A variety of Camp

programs restart mid-September, with varying sizes of groups that carry through the end of the year. August tends to be the driest time of the year, and least active weather and program wise.

The contractor bears responsibility for all cost, timing of material acquisition, and that the specifications are met as a minimum for this project, such as: safety barriers at work areas, dewatering of work area, transportation, crane & operator, forming, certification of proper materials being used, material type & specifications, concrete, hardware, waterproofing, sealants, bonding agent, asphalt, handrails, etc. Disposal of removed debris is at the expense and responsibility of the contractor. The Camp has Happy Hollow located 0.6 miles south of the Camp's main entrance (directly off of State Route 41) where with the approval of the Camp Executive Director, approved debris (fill, sand, gravel, excavated bedrock chips, dirt, etc.) can be disposed of with approval, at agreed upon locations at Happy Hollow. The Camp additionally requests that if the plastic tubes can be removed in an acceptable condition, the Camp will keep the plastic tubes for future projects. The metal tubes and any other debris not approved to be disposed of on Camp grounds must be disposed of at an appropriate site off of Camp property.

INFORMATION FOR BIDDERS

1. PROPOSAL

Proposals are being sought for services to provide labor and equipment to construct and install three concrete box culverts. All material shall be furnished in full accordance with the specifications.

2. RECEIPT AND OPENING OF BIDS

Separate sealed bids, **IN TRIPLICATE**, will be received in the Office of the Executive Director of Butler Springs Christian Camp, 3701 State Route 41, Hillsboro, OH 45133 until the time and date stated in the INVITATION TO BID. Bids shall then be publicly opened and read aloud.

All bids shall be submitted in sealed, opaque envelopes clearly labeled with the name of the bidder, address, and the words "**BID DOCUMENTS - 2024 CULVERT REPLACEMENT PROJECT**"

so as to guard against opening prior to the time set, therefore. Bids may be forwarded by mail. If mailed, the sealed opaque envelope containing the proposal, marked as described above, shall be enclosed in another envelope properly addressed for mailing. Butler Springs Christian Camp may waive any informalities in or reject any and all bids. Any bid may be withdrawn prior to the above scheduled time for the opening thereof.

3. PREPARATION OF PROPOSAL

Each bid must be submitted on the prescribed form and all blank spaces for bid prices must be filled, handwritten in ink or type written, in both words and figures. Bid prices shall include all labor, materials and equipment necessary to complete the work in accordance with the bid documents. **Include a timeline for the project with dates, expected benchmarks, and method being utilized for culvert unit builds (precast or cast-in-place).** Provide cost breakouts for items detailed in specifications (i.e. Summary of Quantities).

4. WITHDRAWAL OF BIDS

Bids may be withdrawn personally or by written request by the bidder in time for delivery in the normal course of business prior to the time fixed for bid opening, provided that written confirmation of any telegraphic withdrawal over the signature of the bidder is placed in the mail and postmarked prior to the time set for bid opening. Negligence on the part of the bidder in preparing his bid confers no right of withdrawal or modification of his bid after such bid has been opened.

5. FAMILIARITY WITH LAWS, SITE CONDITIONS AND DOCUMENTS

Each bidder is required to be familiar with and to comply with the terms and conditions of the specifications and all other Bid documents, and with all Federal, State and County regulations which in any manner relate to the furnishing of the services in accordance with the Bid. Each bidder shall thoroughly familiarize themselves with all conditions of the bid documents and specifications before preparing their proposal. The submission of a proposal shall be construed as an assurance that such examination has been made and the failure of the bidder to familiarize themselves with conditions relating to the specifications shall in no way relieve any bidder **from any obligation** in respect to their bid.

A Non-Mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting will take place on Tuesday, May 16, 2024 at 10:00 a.m., Bidders are encouraged to attend to see and hear information about the site and project. The meeting will begin in the Fireside Room across the hall from the Camp Office at 3701 State Route 41, Hillsboro, OH 45133.

6. TAX EXEMPTION

Butler Springs Christian Camp is exempt from paying sales tax and, for that reason; the bid price shall not include any sales tax on the items specified. EIN 31-0581700 501(c)(3) Non-Profit Religious Organization – Church

7. QUALIFICATIONS OF BIDDER

Bidders must be regular full-time contractors in the type of service specified. Butler Springs Christian Camp may make such investigations as it deems necessary to determine the ability of the bidder to perform the work, and the bidder shall furnish to Butler Springs Christian Camp all such information and data for this purpose as may be requested. The Board of Butler Springs Christian Camp reserves the right to reject any bid should the evidence submitted by, or investigation of such bidder fails to satisfy the Board that such bidder is properly qualified to carry out the obligations of the Bid and to complete the project contemplated therein. Conditional bids can be accepted but may be cause for rejection.

8. ERRORS, INTERPRETATIONS AND ADDENDA

Should a bidder find any omissions, discrepancies or errors in the specifications or other Bid Documents or should they be in doubt as to the meaning of the Specifications or other Bid Documents, they should immediately notify the Executive Director of Butler Springs Christian Camp, who may correct, amend or clarify such documents by a written interpretation or addendum. No oral interpretations shall be made to any bidder **and no oral statement shall be effective to modify any of the provisions of the Bid Documents.**

9. METHOD OF AWARD - LOWEST QUALIFIED BIDDER

Butler Springs Christian Camp reserves the right to reject any or all bids and may waive any informalities.

The Bid will be awarded to the responsible bidder submitting the bid that results in the lowest net

cost and best value to Butler Springs Christian Camp while complying with all conditions set forth in these Bid Documents. The experience and qualifications of the bidder shall be factors considered in the awarding of a bid and may result in an award to a contractor other than the low bidder. In the event that there is a discrepancy between the prices written in words and in figures, the price written in words shall govern.

10. SUBCONTRACTORS

The bidder (contractor) is specifically advised that any person, firm, or other party to whom it is proposed to award a subcontract under this Bid, shall have in place a valid Certificate of Ohio Workers Compensation enforce and that noted Liability Insurance limits are covered (either directly by the subcontractor or a part of the Contractor's coverages). Additionally, the contractor is responsible for the scope of work, quality of work, and payment of services provided by subcontractors.

11 RIGHTS OF THE OWNER TO TERMINATE PROJECT

In the event that any of the provisions of this Bid are violated by the Bidder (Contractor), or by any of its subcontractors, Butler Springs Christian Camp may serve written notice upon the Contractor of its intention to terminate the Work, such notices to contain the reasons for such intention to terminate the Work. Unless within five (5) days after the serving of such notice upon the Contractor, such violation or delay shall cease and a satisfactory arrangement of correction be made, the project shall, upon expiration of said five (5) days, cease and terminate. In the event of any such termination, Butler Springs Christian Camp shall immediately serve notice thereof upon the Contractor. In the event of such termination, Butler Spring Christian Camp may take over the work or any portion thereof, and prosecute the same, by contract or any other method, for the account and at the expense of the Contractor, and the Contractor shall be liable for any excess cost occasioned by Butler Springs Christian Camp as a result of such termination.

12. PAYMENTS

Estimates and /or invoices shall be furnished to the Executive Director of Butler Springs Christian Camp for verification and approval of the amount of work done and the amount earned by the Contractor. Final payment will not be made until approval by the Board of Butler Springs Christian Camp of all work complete. The Contractor agrees that they will indemnify and save the Butler Springs Christian Camp harmless for all claims growing out of the lawful demands of subcontractors, laborers, suppliers, and assignees. Payments will be made Net 15 days after Approval of Work Completed per the payment schedule. 15% retainage will be withheld pending clearance of the final punch list and the Board's Acceptance of Completed Scope of Project.

Payment Schedule – 15% down will be provided with the award of the contract. Two additional payments will be at benchmark points agreed upon with the Bidder prior to the award of the contract, and the final payment of the 15% retainage with the noted conditions above.

13. GUARANTEE

All equipment and materials including all parts and assemblies, if applicable, shall be guaranteed against defects in material and workmanship for a period of at least one (1) year after acceptance. Guarantee shall commence at the time of official acceptance by the Board of Butler Spring Christian Camp. Where it is required for the Contractor to repair, replace, resurface, replant or to modify, alter, add, or remove hardware, parts, components, or related accessories for the purpose of insuring proper appearance, performance or operation, such work shall be done as required by the Contractor until such time as acceptable performance has been established. Problems which occur shall be corrected in an appropriate fashion under guarantee. The Contractor shall be responsible for attending to and remedy such items within a reasonable amount of time. Appropriate logs and schedules shall be maintained to reflect these items and their redress.

18. SCHEDULING OF WORK

If notified of the acceptance of this proposal within the acceptance period, the bidder agrees to promptly schedule the work and submit verification of having scheduled the work within five (5) working days of such notice. The successful bidder shall plan to do the on-site work within the timeframes provided in the Bid Documents and provide their expected work plan with dates and benchmarks. The contract winner shall prosecute the work diligently for the duration of the project. Each bidder shall furnish the number of days needed to complete the work (from notice to proceed to finish) with his bid. The Contractor's committed schedule to execute the entire work will be considered along with the submitted price in determining the successful bidder.

Prospective bidders are advised that time is of the essence of this Contract.

19. PERFORMANCE, LABOR, AND MATERIALS PAYMENT BONDS

GENERAL CONDITIONS

The Executive Director, Chris Osborne or designee shall be the Contractor's direct contact. Periodic conferences will be held to review the status of work progress.

The Contractor shall employ only honest and responsible employees, skilled in the tasks assigned to them. The Contractor shall be responsible for all conduct of their employees and subcontractors.

All work shall be completed in a thoroughly professional and workmanlike manner in strict accordance with the Bid Documents.

Butler Springs Christian Camp reserves the right to establish the order of priority for completion of the various portions of the work and to delete any portion of the work upon notification of the Contractor.

The Contractor agrees to indemnify Butler Springs Christian Camp (BSCC) against and save BSCC harmless from any and all liability and loss from any claim, suit, or action based upon any alleged injury or death of any person including any employee of the Contractor or subcontractor, and for damage to any property that may occur or that may be alleged to have occurred in the course of the performance of the work, or from failure to guard the same, whether such act or failure to act is by the Contractor or any subcontractor or anyone directly or indirectly employed by any of them or by anyone for whose acts any of them maybe liable, and the Contractor agrees at its own expense to pay all charges for attorneys in connection with the defense against any such claim, and if any judgment should be rendered against BSCC in any such action, the Contractor will satisfy and discharge the same without cost or expense to BSCC.

Before commencing work, the Contractor shall obtain and deliver certificates of insurance to the Executive Director of BSCC and during the performance of the work, the Contractor shall maintain insurance of the kinds and in at least the amounts specified hereunder in a form satisfactory to BSCC; such certificates shall contain a provision that Butler Springs Christian Camp shall be given thirty (30) days advance written notice by registered mail of, modification, change, termination, cancellation or expiration of coverage. Renewal certificates shall be provided at least 60 days prior to expiration of the policy. With each Certificate of Insurance, the contractor shall provide a separate endorsement naming Butler Springs Christian Camp as an "Additional insured". Such endorsement shall include the following language "Butler Springs Christian Camp is an additional named insured". The cost of such insurance shall be the sole responsibility of the Contractor. The Contractor shall require each Subcontractor employed on the Project to maintain the coverage listed below unless the Contractor's insurance covers

activities of the Subcontractor on the Project.

1. Provide a currently valid Certificate of Ohio Workers Compensation.
2. Certificate of Liability Insurance - Broad Form Commercial General Liability including premises and operations, products, completed operations, contractual liability, independent contractors, and broad form property damage coverage, written on a "per occurrence" basis with minimum combined coverage for bodily injury, personal injury, and property damage liability of \$1,000,000 general annual aggregate, \$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$1,000,000 Products/Completed Operations Aggregate.
3. Comprehensive Automobile Liability, covering all vehicles used by Contractor in the course of work, including owned, non-owned and hired with minimum coverage of \$2,000,000 combined single limit for bodily injury and property damage.
4. Excess Liability with minimum coverage of \$2,000,000 in umbrella form.

If any policy is written on a "Claims Made" basis the retroactive date must be prior to or coincident with the date of the Contract and the Certificate shall state that the coverage is a "Claims made" and shall also state the retroactive date. The policy must be continually renewed for a minimum of two years from the completion date of the contract, or the Contractor must purchase an Extended Reporting Period endorsement or shall purchase Prior Acts Coverage.

All Coverage is to be provided on a primary noncontributory basis.

All insurance shall be provided by a company authorized to do business in the State of Ohio and having an A.M. Best rating of no less than A-VIII.

The insurer shall agree to waive all rights of subrogation against Butler Springs Christian Camp, its Board, employees, and volunteers for losses arising from work performed by the Contractor for Butler Springs Christian Camp.

No insurance required or furnished hereunder shall in any way relieve the Contractor of or diminish any of his responsibilities, obligations, and liabilities under the Contract.

SCOPE OF WORK

Butler Springs Christian Camp

2024 CULVERT REPLACEMENT PROJECT

The Board of Butler Springs Christian Camp intends to issue a contract for improvements to three driveway stream crossings within the camp, consisting of removal of current driveway pipes at the three locations, that currently have either corrugated galvanized steel or smooth wall plastic pipe (18" & 24" sizes). The pipe tubes will be replaced with three-sided concrete box culverts at all three of the locations within the Camp, per the attached specifications provided by PreTek Group. The work shall be in strict conformance with the documents of this RFP. **All work must be completed within 7 weeks.** The contractor shall include in their base bid all premium time charges they deem necessary to meet the schedule. Inclement weather shall not grant the general contractor an extension of time. Due to the need to maintain emergency access to all parts of the camp, coordination of the work on the three crossings shall be approved by the Camp, to not have all of the crossing down at any one time.

A. Scope of Work

The scope of work specifically includes but is not limited to the following.

1. Installation, maintaining, and removal of erosion control.
2. Dewatering.
3. Provide orange temporary barriers, and gates to secure the project sites.
4. Removal and disposal of the existing pipes and paving. Materials removed shall be disposed of by the general contractor, unless otherwise agreed upon. There shall be no charge to Butler Springs Christian Camp for the disposal.
5. Due to site limitations any stockpiling of bulk or earth materials at the site must be in approved locations.
6. FOR PRE-CAST OPTION - If required due to the width of the road, prepare temporary pads for the crane's outriggers.
7. FOR PRE-CAST OPTION - Receive, unload, and set the precast concrete culvert and precast concrete end and wing walls.
Note the general contractor shall contract directly for the crane rigging services to set the culvert & end and wing wall sections based on a 10-hour day. Any time required beyond the 10-hour day will be the responsibility of the general contractor and paid for by them.
8. Receive, unload, and set the end and wing walls.
9. Saw cut, fine grade and repair pavement cut sections as shown on the bid documents. Pavement shall be placed in two, two-inch compacted lifts. The cost of materials will be paid for by the contractor.
10. All areas, roadways, driveways, lawns, etc. shall be restored to their pre-existing conditions.

B. Items Excluded

In addition to the items noted above the following is specifically excluded from the scope of work.

1. Furnishing and installation of guard rails.
2. Traffic detour signage

INDEMNIFICATION CERTIFICATE
Butler Springs Christian Camp
2024 CULVERT REPLACEMENT PROJECT

To the fullest extent permitted by law, the contractor shall indemnify and hold harmless the Butler Springs Christian Camp, and agents and employees of said Camp from and against claims, damages, losses and expenses, including but not limited to attorney's fees, arising out of or resulting from performance of the work, provided that such claim, damage, loss or expense is attributable to bodily injury, sickness, disease or death, or to injury to or destruction of tangible property (other than the work itself) including loss or use resulting therefrom, but only to the extent caused in whole or in part by acts or omissions of the general contractor, a subcontractor, anyone directly or indirectly employed by them or anyone for whose acts they may be liable, regardless of whether or not such claim, damage, loss or expense is caused in part by a party indemnified hereunder.

Such obligation shall not be construed to negate, abridge, or reduce other rights or obligations of indemnity which would otherwise exist as to Butler Springs Christian Camp. In claims against any person or entity indemnified under this paragraph by an employee of the general contractor, a subcontractor, anyone directly or indirectly employed by them or anyone for whose acts they may be liable, the indemnification obligation under this paragraph shall not be limited by a limitation on amount or type of damages, compensation or benefits payable by or for the contractor or a subcontractor under workers' or workmen's compensation acts, disability benefits acts or other employee benefits acts.
